CYPRESS

One of the most common staples of the Italian landscape. Not only do they create a majestic frame to the Tuscan landscape, but they also serve as wind-breakers to protect the land.

LAVENDER

Aromatic herbs and fragrant plants such as lavender are often used to provide a pleasant sensory experience. Lavender also provides a nice color contrast to the traditional bright, bold red and gold flowering plants.

GRAPES

Rows of grapes can often be seen growing along the hillsides, yet its most prominent and widely planted grape is the Sangiovese grape in the Chianti region.
